What you'll need to vote

Make sure you bring one of these accepted forms of identification:

- Texas Driver License issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)
- · United States Passport (book or card)
- United States Military Identification Card containing the person's photograph
- United States Citizenship Certificate containing the person's photograph
- · Texas Handgun License issued by DPS
- Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS
- Texas Personal Identification Card issued by DPS

Don't have an acceptable form of ID?

If a voter does not possess and cannot reasonably obtain a photo ID, they may still cast a regular ballot by presenting a supporting form of ID and executing a Reasonable Impediment Declaration, noting the voter's reasonable impediment to obtaining an acceptable form of photo identification.

About the ballot

Find your specific sample ballot at HarrisVotes.com. The items on your ballot may vary depending on which area of the county you reside.

When you go vote, you can bring a marked sample ballot or a Voters Guide into the voting booth with you.

If you have a disability or need translation support, please ask for assistance.
