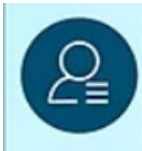

-  Tarping roofs
-  Mold mitigation

FEMA RESOURCES**

FEMA announced federal emergency aid has been made available to the state of Texas to supplement state, tribal and local recovery efforts in areas affected by a severe winter storm beginning on Feb. 11, 2021 and continuing. Individuals and business owners who sustained losses in the designated area can begin applying for assistance by registering online at <http://www.DisasterAssistance.gov> or by calling 1-800-621-3362 or 1-800-462-7585 TTY.



Houston-Harris County Emergency Rental Assistance Program

The City of Houston and Harris County are working together to provide \$159 million in rent and utilities assistance to families who are struggling due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The funds will be distributed by two agencies with established experience in helping people in need: BakerRipley and Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston. To make the process as smooth as possible, a group of community agencies will serve as navigators, helping families complete their applications.

The program opens on February 25, 2021.

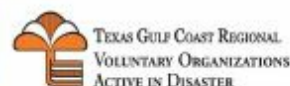
